Notes

The following actions are prohibited in the Metro System. Violators will be fined according to the law.

- 1) Smoking.
- 2) Spitting (including betel-nut juice, and chewed remains).
- 3) Littering (cigarette butt, chewing gum, fruit or fruit peels, betel nut juice and other refuse).
- 4) Eating or drinking in food-free areas (including chewing gum or betel nut).
- 5) Playing on the platform, crossing yellow warning line or walking or running on the escalator without following the directions, or conducting other behaviors that influence operational orders and traffic safety as well as without observing to the dissuasion.

Permitted lingering time in paid areas :

- 1) 2 hours maximum when entering and exiting different stations; 15 mins maximum when entering and exiting same stations.
- 2) In addition to the original fare, persons exceeding the above time limits will also be charged the required fare equal to the minimum single-journey ticket price. For E-tickets users, the fee will be charged automatically at the gate.

Children under 115cm or over 115cm but under the age of 6 (ID required) may ride free under the condition of being accompanied by a paying passenger. Each paying passenger may accompany up to 2 children.



Pets must be crated, except police dogs or guide dogs. The head, tail and limbs of the pet should not be exposed. Each paying passenger is limited to carrying one crated animal.

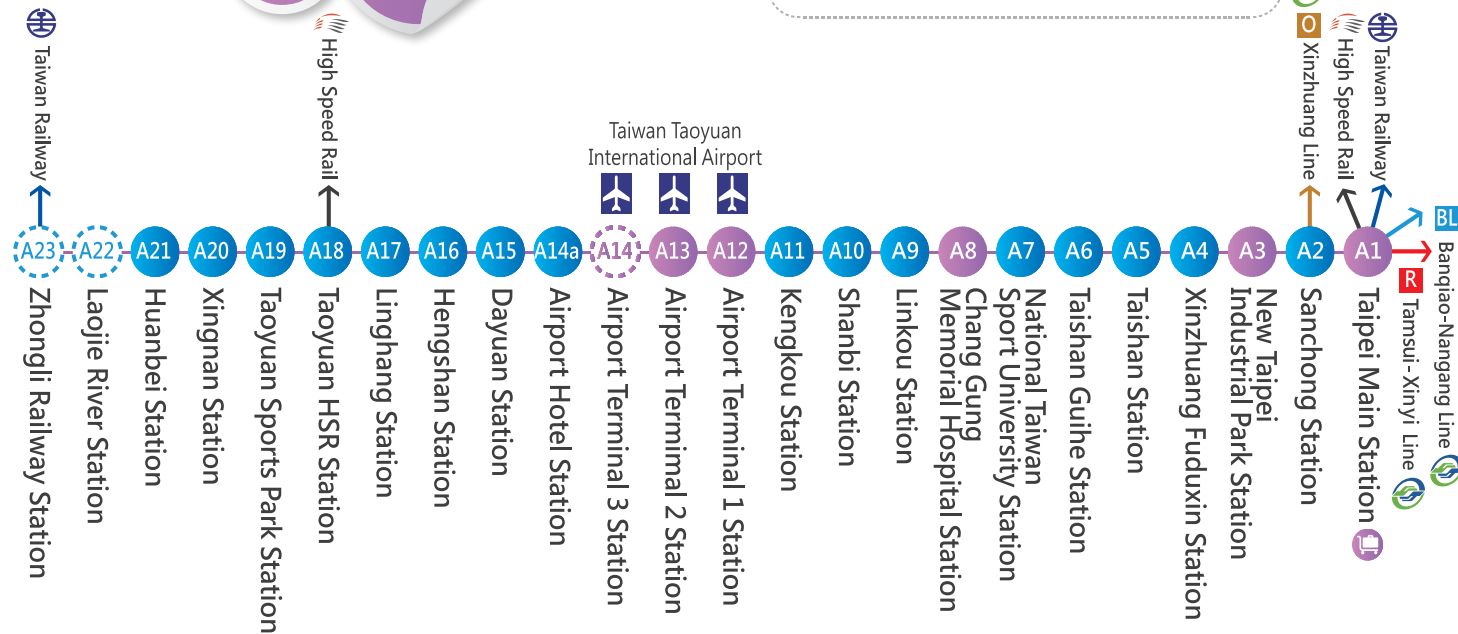
